Campground Guidelines & Rules

To ensure all campers enjoy their experience at Loon Lake Campground, we ask that you please follow these simple rules.

1. For the safety of your children, parents must accompany children to the swimming beach. There is no lifeguard on duty.
2. Limit of two dogs per campsite. **Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.** Please remember, some children and adults are afraid of dogs. Please clean up after your dog and keep barking to a minimum. **Dogs are not allowed at the swimming beach.** If your dogs love the water, try using the public boat landing which is within walking distance of the campground.
3. No bathing in the lake. Shampoo/soap can be harmful to the wild life. We have shower facilities at the campground.
4. Quiet hours are from 11 pm - 8 am. Be respectful to your neighbors and keep your voices low and stereos/radio/TV volumes down.
5. To help prevent Emerald Ash Borer disease, **please do not bring your own firewood into the campground.** Firewood is available for purchase at the campground.
6. No 4-wheeling/ATVs **within** the Campground; use trails as regulated by the State of WI.
7. Fireworks are NOT permitted at our Campground.
8. Vandalism is not tolerated. Any person caught vandalizing the campground property will be evicted and charged for the damage. Parents will be held responsible for their children's actions.
9. Watch your vocabulary and avoid offensive and vulgar expressions.
10. Please keep your campsite clean. Please put your garbage in the garbage can provided by the campground, and do not put anything in your fire pit that will not burn, including glass, cans, plastic bottles, diapers etc.
11. **Please help us keep the environment clean – recycle!** Please keep your aluminum cans separate from the rest of your garbage, leave them next to your garbage can when you leave, and they will be picked up at the end of the weekend.
